There are several proposed changes to be made along the Hanover Pike that will make for a safer highway while improving the flow of traffic. Currently there are site plans being developed for proposed improvements at the intersection of Emory Road and Hanover Pike. A storm water management pond or holding area will be constructed in the farm fields south east of the intersection. Preliminary engineering work started several years ago to upgrade this intersection to meet the increase in traffic along the Hanover Pike and at this intersection.
